

## 2018-19 POSTERING INFORMATION

- Posters are put up for our 6 main stage shows in all postering locations.
- For volunteers who poster in Hanover, Hartford/Norwich/Wilder, Lebanon, Quechee/Woodstock, West Lebanon, or White River Junction, you will also put up posters for New Works Now in January and two of our education shows (in March and July)
- Posterers who return their completed poster sheet **before the first preview** of each show are eligible to redeem either of these voucher options:\*)  
2 vouchers to a preview (*Must poster at least 10 places*)  
1 voucher to a regular performance
- Posterers who return their sheet **after the first preview but before opening night** will receive one voucher.
- Posterers who return their sheet **after opening night** will not receive vouchers.

  - WHITE RIVER JUNCTION, VT
  - WINDSOR, VT
- Each location contains 10-40 places where posters should go up. Open hours (based on Google Maps info) are listed in the notes column when available.
- Posterers should take note of changes on their poster sheets (any new or closed businesses, changes in open hours, changed names, etc), and contact the Box Office with updates. Poster locations are updated by the Volunteer Coordinator after every show to streamline the process.

*\*For the fall repertory, posterers may choose one of these three options:*

*2 vouchers for 1st show previews*

*2 vouchers for 2nd show previews*

*2 vouchers: 1 for 1st show previews, 1 for 2nd show previews*
