

## **Summer Carpenter**

Northern Stage, a LORT D 240 theater in White River Junction, VT, seeks experienced Carpenters for its 2022 summer season. Northern Stage produces a summer mainstage season featuring an outdoor musical in the 200 seat Courtyard Theatre and indoor education programming in the 240 seat Byrne theatre. This position will work closely with the scene shop staff to execute all necessary scenic activity for the two summer productions as well as assist with building and striking the outdoor Courtyard Theatre under the leadership of the Technical Director.

### **Responsibilities include but are not limited to:**

- Work with the TD and shop staff to build, load in, and strike each production.
- Assist in maintaining shop equipment/inventory, and in keeping the scene shop clean and safe.
- Assist in installing the outdoor Courtyard Theatre.
- Finish work (molding and some painting).
- Support other production departments as needed, and promote a safe and healthy work/learning environment alongside other staff and apprentices.

### **Qualifications:**

- 1+ year of professional theater carpentry and/or related educational experience.
- Knowledge of theatrical building techniques.
- Ability to read construction drawings and build plans.
- Excellent communication and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work independently and in collaboration with others.
- Ability to prioritize, multi-task, and work quickly and accurately with attention to detail, maintaining a positive attitude in stressful environments.
- Proficiency in hand and power tools.
- Rigging, welding, and steel fabrication experience a plus.
- Valid driver's license and ability to drive a box truck.
