

Dresser for *The Railway Children*:

Northern Stage, a LORT D 240 seat regional theater in White River Junction, VT, seeks an experienced Dresser to run the new musical: *The Railway Children*. Northern Stage produces a mainstage season, an education season, a New Works festival, and 4-6 other events year-round. The Dresser will work closely with the Wardrobe Supervisor to execute all wardrobe-related activity necessary to the production.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Run a wardrobe track for *The Railway Children*.
- Assist the Wardrobe Supervisor to prep, track, and maintain all costumes, shoes, wigs/hair, and accessories from tech through closing.
- Perform minor repairs on costumes/accessories with support from the Wardrobe Supervisor and full time Costume Shop staff.
- Assist the Wardrobe Supervisor in maintaining show related paperwork.
- Promote a safe and healthy work/learning environment for cast and staff.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree or 1+ years professional experience in theatrical dressing.
- Experience running wardrobe tracks through long show runs.
- Exceptional organizational skills, including proficiency using Google Suite.
- Experience working with Equity performers and stage managers.
- Experience working with non-professional child actors.
- High degree of interpersonal and communication skills.
